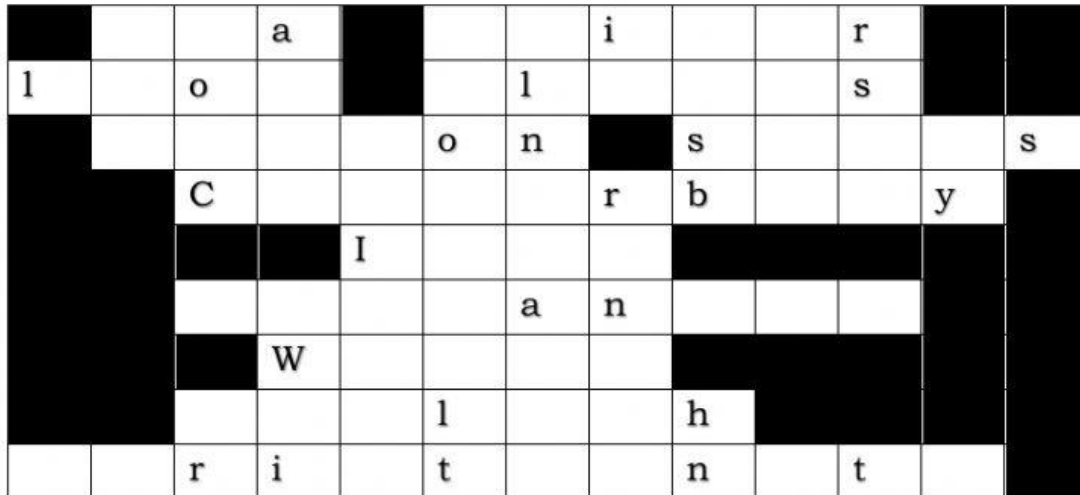
Activity 1:
