Read the nursery rhymes carefully and write the rhyme scheme next to the lines in the stanzas.

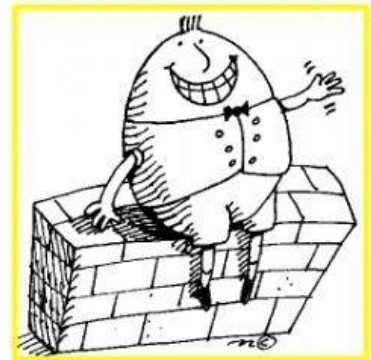


Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star
