| Term | Definition |
|---------------|--|
| soil | the top layer of soil, which contains the most nutrients |
| Humus | mixture made up of broken-down rock and the decayed remains of once-living things |
| soil horizons | related to living things or made from once-living matter |
| topsoil | the part of soil formed by decaying remains of plants and animals |
| organic | layers of soil that contain different amounts of weathered rock and organic material |
