| (5) wedding invitation | () A male friend or relative that helps the groom on his wedding day. |
| (6) best man | () To drink to the health or in honour of (someone or something) |
| (7) bride | () The bride and groom speak about their feelings for each other. |
| (8) veil | () A little girl who carries flowers at the start of the ceremony |
| (9) guests | () A young boy who takes care of the rings until they are needed. |
