In 1522, Juan Sebastián Elcano sailed around the Earth for the first time. He demonstrated that the shape of the Earth is round, not flat.

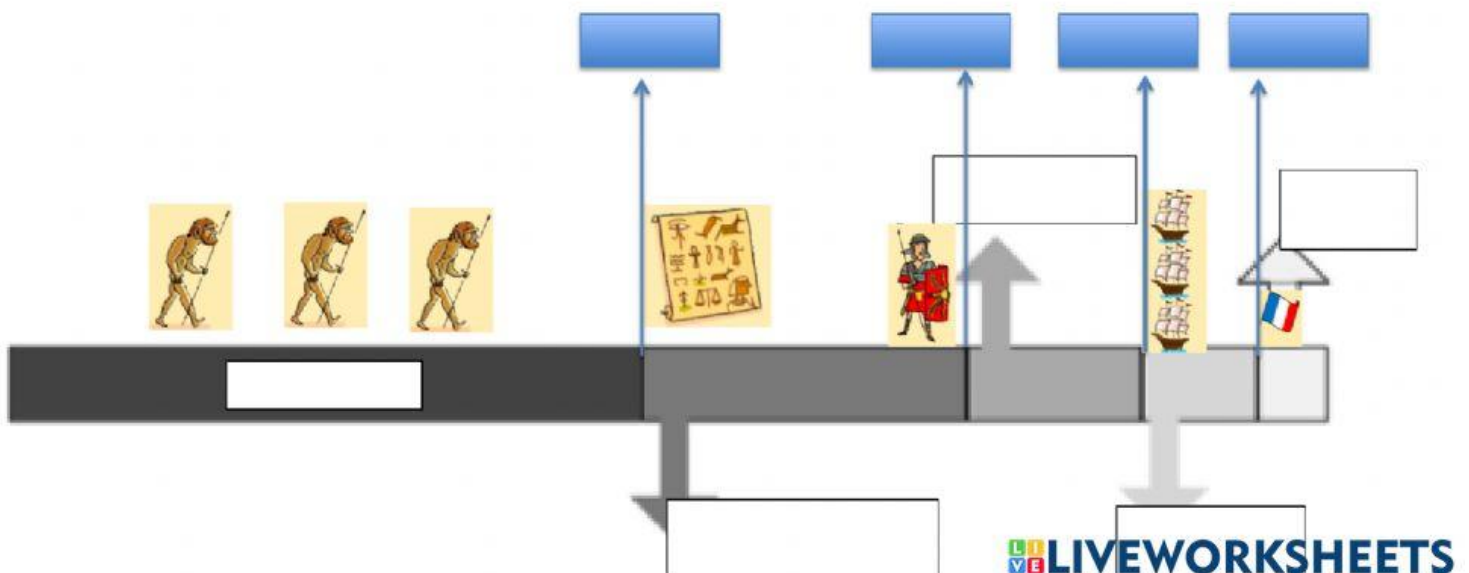

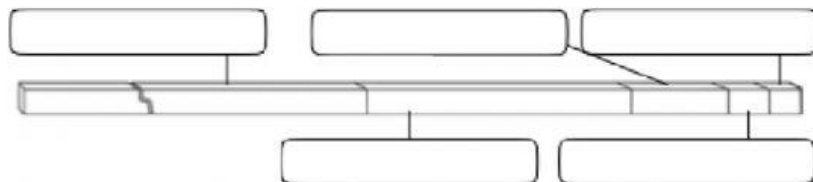

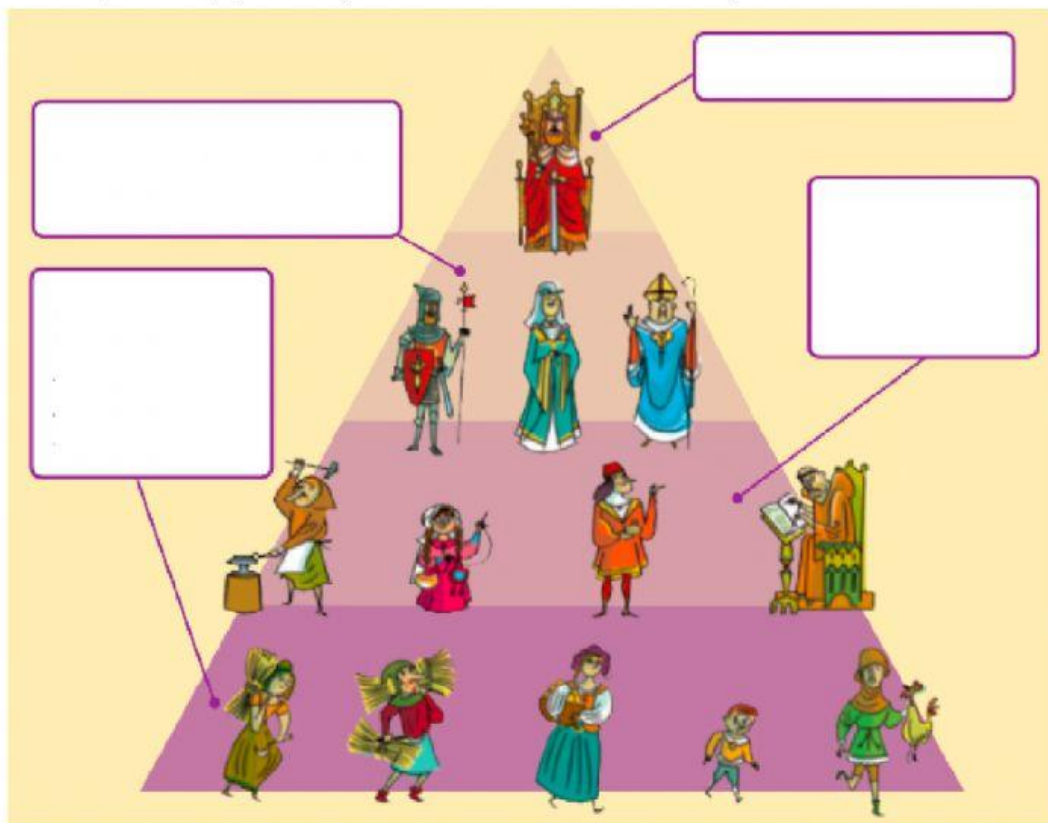
