to send something through the air with force

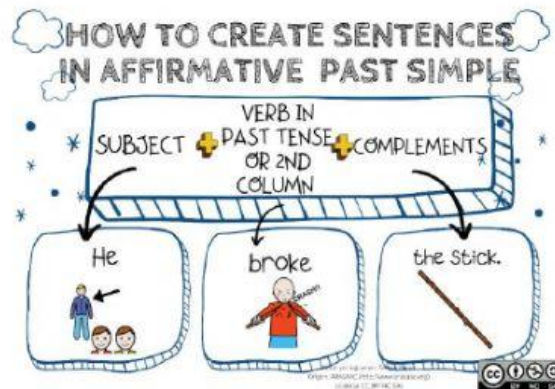
to (cause someone to) be in a position in which the lower part of the body is resting on a seat, with the upper part of the body vertical.
