


## IRREGULAR VERBS 15

to no longer have something because you do not know where it is.

**Lose**

to see and talk to someone for the first time

**Know**

to send something through the air with force

**Run**


to (cause someone to) be in a position in which the lower part of the body is resting on a seat, with the upper part of the body vertical.
