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- Jessica is measuring two line segments.  
The first line segment is **15 cm** long.  
The second line segment is **50 mm** long.  
How long are the two line segments together? (answer in cm)



**Answer:** Together both lines are 20 cm long

## Word problem #2

kg	hg	dag	g	dg	cg	mg
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- David received a box of **5 kg** of oranges  
If he made juice with **800 g** of oranges.  
How many **grams** of oranges does David have left?



**Answer:** David has left 4200 grams of oranges
