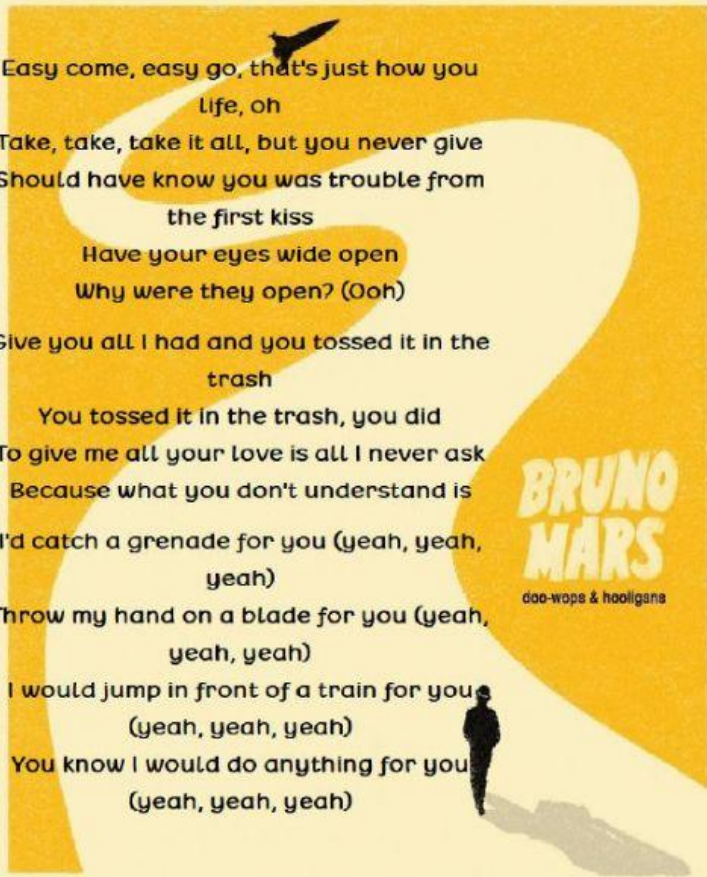


Grenade by Bruno Mars
