

UNIT 6- Adverbs of manner

Adverbs of manner describe HOW we do an action.

How = Cómo

Example:

- How does Michael Phelps swim?
- o He is very quick. He swims quickly.

Quickly is an adverb of manner.



RULES TO FORM ADVERBS OF MANNER

To form adverbs of manner we use the **adjectives**:

ADJECTIVES	ADVERBS	Explanation
Quick ^k Slow ^w Bad ^d Quiet ^t Loud ^d Careful ^l Dangerous ^s Sad ^d	Quickly ^{ly} Slowly ^{ly} Badly ^{ly} Quietly ^{ly} Loudly ^{ly} Carefully ^{ly} Dangerously ^{ly} Sadly ^{ly}	When the adjectives finish in consonant , we add -ly to form the adverb.
Happy ^y Angry ^y Sleepy ^y	Happily ^{ily} Angrily ^{ily} Sleepily ^{ily}	When the adjectives finish in "y" , this changes into "i" . Then we add -ly to form the adverb.
Good Fast	Well Fast	Irregular cases.
