Early one morning, while looking out of your bedroom window, you see animal tracks in the dirt. You decide to follow them to see where they would take you. Write a story to tell about what happened.

In your story be sure to tell:

- why you followed the animal tracks;
- where the tracks led you;
- whether or not you found an animal;
- how you felt;
- one or two exciting things that happened on the journey;
- whether anyone was there with you;
- how the trip ended.
