

- When something is **open-ended**, it is not final.
- A **drive-in** is a place where people get served while in their cars.
- When you **troubleshoot**, you eliminate problems.
- Energy from the sun is **solar energy**.
- Know-how** means "expertise."
- If something is **low-key**, it is played down.
- A **getaway** is an exit.
- A **health club** is a place with exercise equipment.




