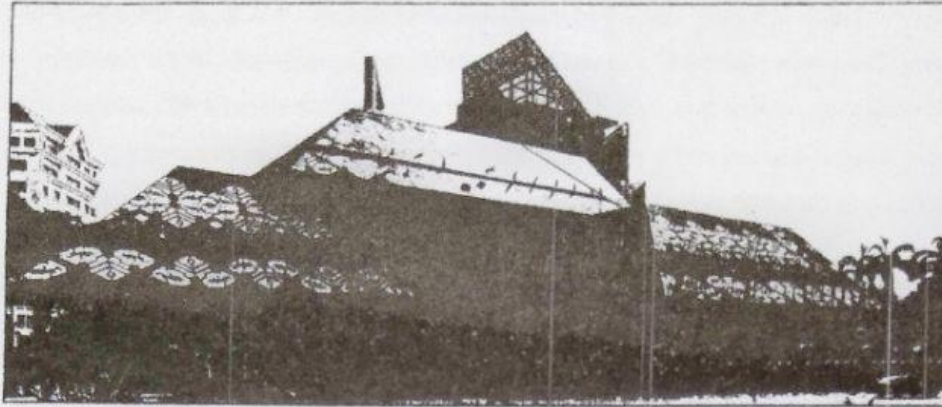

The National Library



The National Library was set up with the aim to inculcate the love of reading among Malaysians, and to showcase our national heritage. So, the design of the building is very special. The roof is based on the concept of the traditional Malay headgear known as the *tengkolok*. This headgear is a symbol of intelligence and respect in the Malay culture. Another interesting feature of the roof is that it lets sunlight in, so it is very bright and airy inside the building. The tiles on the roof are also special because the patterns resemble the *kain songket*, a traditional hand woven cloth.

There are five levels in the library. At each level, there are different divisions that provide various services to the visitors and members including information services, support services, library network and library collection.

There is a good collection of reading materials in the National Library. This is to provide knowledge at national level for the present and future generations. The National Library is very proud of its Malaysiana Collection. This collection is made up of library materials published in Malaysia and overseas. Another collection is the Malay Manuscripts which comprises of the legend of Hang Tuah, a famous Malay folklore. This collection is regarded as a national heritage.

The National Library also provides a hypermedia centre with many kinds of multimedia and IT facilities for visitors and members to use. These facilities help people from all walks of life to acquire knowledge via technology.

Another interesting facility is the Children's Section on the ground floor. Besides a wide collection of books, there are many activities to promote reading among children such as storytelling hour, reading programmes and the children's theatre.
