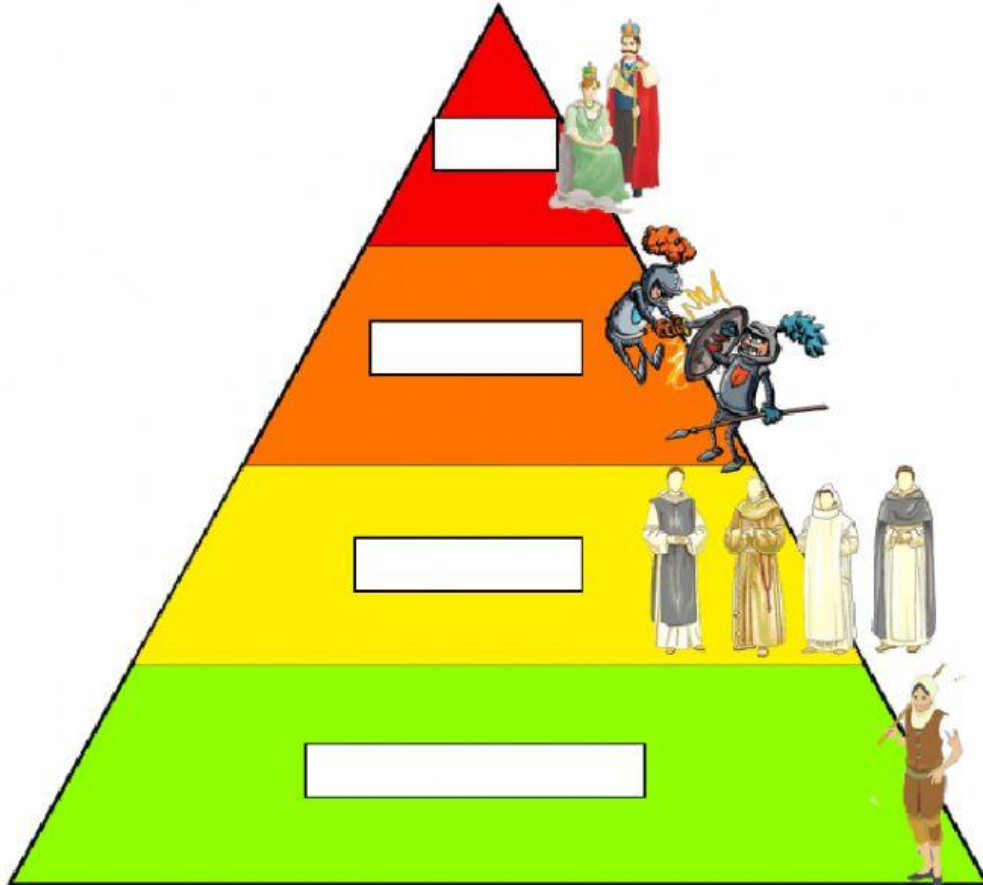


MIDDLE AGES
