Tell Where and Show Directions

Prepositions can tell where things are.

*My house is **next to** the park.*

Prepositions can tell a direction, or a way to go.

*I walk **to** the park.*

Location	on, under, beside, in, next to, behind, in front of, between
Direction	across, to, up, around, out, down, into
