Are you **going to go** swimming tomorrow?

What **are** you **going to do** on Saturday?

He is = He's

He is not = He isn't

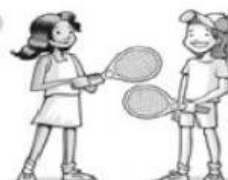
