

SENTENCE STRUCTURE

AFFIRMATIVE

I/you/we/they **have** worked.

He/she/it **has** worked.

NEGATIVE

I/you/we/they **haven't** worked.

He/she/it **hasn't** worked.

INTERROGATIVE

Have I/you/we/they worked?

Has he/she/it worked?

SHORT ANSWERS

Yes, I/you/we/they **have**.

No, he/she/it **hasn't**.

LONG AND SHORT FORMS

I have been to Paris.

I've been to Paris.

You have not played tennis.

You haven't played tennis.

3rd Person

She has been to London.

She's been to London.

Peter has not written a book.

Peter hasn't written a book.
