1. Rachel planted 3 different varieties of flowers in her garden each day for 16 days. How many flowers did she plant in all?

2. Allen blew bubbles outside for an hour. Dana blew bubbles for one-third of that time. How many minutes did Dana blow bubbles?

3. Craig bought 48 strawberries, 31 blueberries and 26 apricots at the farmer's market. How many fruits did Craig buy in all?

4. There are 91 days in spring. If it rains for 24 of those days, how many days will it be sunny?

5. Tammy, Wendy and Marie are having a picnic at the park. If each girl has brought 4 foods to eat, how many foods do they have all together?
