

# Conjunctions

## and / or / but

- It is used to join two parts of the sentence.
- Examples: and, or, but

Conjunctions	Uses	Examples
and	It is used to connect two ideas.	(idea) and (idea) <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• I've got a sister <b>and</b> two brothers.</li></ul>
or	It is used to offer a choice.	(choice) or (choice) <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Do you like ice cream <b>or</b> chocolate?</li></ul>
but	It is used to connect ideas that are contrast.	(idea) but (idea) <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• I love fruit <b>but</b> I am allergic to strawberries.</li><li>• He is fat <b>but</b> he can run fast.</li></ul>
