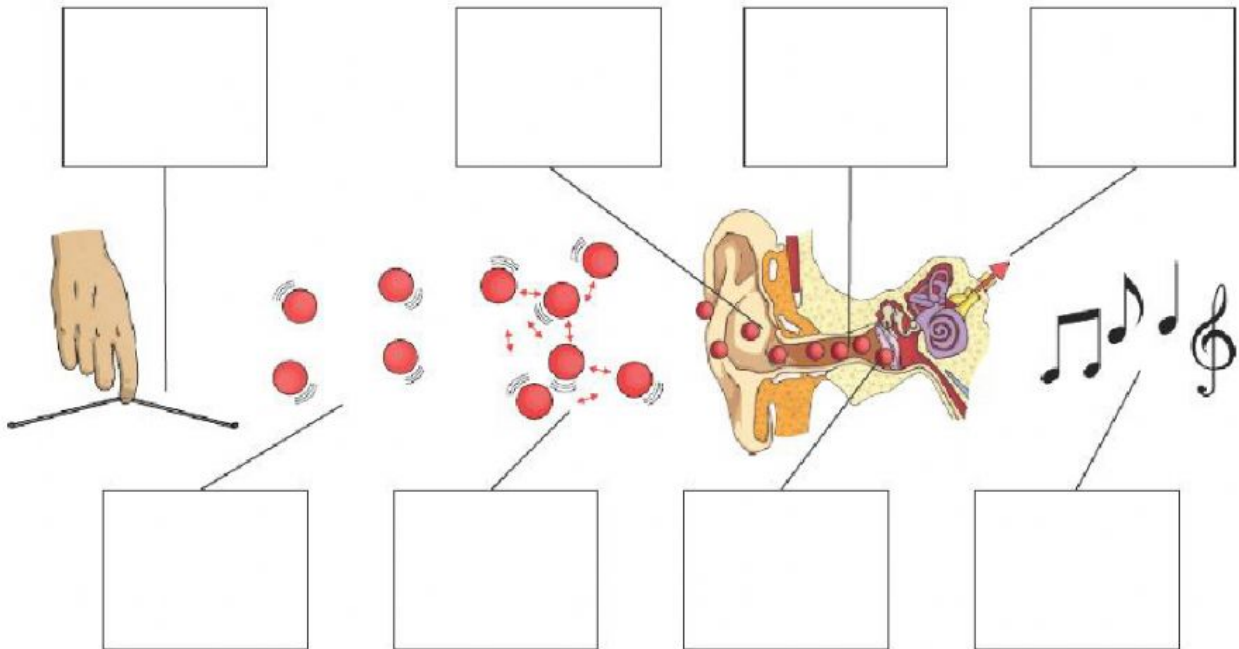

LO: How does sound travel to the ear recap.

Cut out the labels below and stick them in the correct place in the diagram to show how sounds are heard by the ear.



The vibrations pass from particle to particle.	Vibrations pass from the sound source to particles in the air around it.	The vibrations reach your eardrum.	The vibrations reach your ear.
The sound source begins to vibrate.	The vibrations travel along your ear canal.	The vibrations are changed to electrical signals and sent to your brain.	Your brain tells you that you have heard a sound.
