

HAVE TO / DON'T HAVE TO

Pronouns	Affirmative sentences	Negative sentences	Questions
I, we, you, they	I have to get up early.	I do not have to get up early.	Do I have to get up early?
he, she, it	She has to get up early.	She does not have to get up early.	Does she have to get up early?

REMEMBER: **do** + **not** = don't **does** + **not** = doesn't

Choose **"have to"** / **"has to"** in the affirmative (AFF) sentences

or **"don't have to"** / **"doesn't have to"** in the negative (NEG) sentences.

1. They write a test. (AFF)
2. She clean her desk. (NEG)
3. Ken and Liz learn English words. (NEG)
4. Andy help his brother. (AFF)
5. We do our homework. (AFF)
6. He write with a pencil. (NEG)
7. I feed the hamster. (AFF)
8. You take photos. (NEG)
9. Victoria read the newspaper. (AFF)
10. The teacher send a text message. (NEG)
