

Past Simple Regular verbs

Spelling rules for simple past regular verbs

- most of the verbs + **ed** example: play – play**ed**
- verbs ending in “e” + **d** example: arrive -arriv**d**
- one syllable verb ending in consonant-vocal-consonant: double consonant+
ed

Example: stop –stop**ped**

- verbs ending in consonant +y : +ied example: try - tri**ed**
