PEOPLE IN CRIME		DEFINITION
1. shoplifter		a person who deliberately destroys or damages public or private property
2. judge		a person who practices or studies law; an attorney or a counsellor.
3. burglar		Person who steals wallets, money, etc. from people's pockets
4. vandal		a thief who steals from someone by threatening violence.
5. witness		a public official appointed to decide cases in a court of law.
6. pickpocket		a person who gives money or granting favours to influence another person's decisions or behavior
7. briber		a public official appointed to decide cases in a court of law.
8. graffiti artist		A person who breaks into a house in order to steal something
9. bank robber		a person who demands money or another benefit from someone in return for not revealing compromising information.
10. lawyer		a person who paints graffiti in public places.
11. detective		a person who uses computers to gain unauthorized access to data.
12. mugger		a person who sees an event, typically a crime or accident, take place
13. blackmailer		a person, especially a police officer, whose occupation is to investigate and solve crimes.
14. hacker		someone who steals from a bank, often using violence
15. judge	1	A person who steals something from a store
