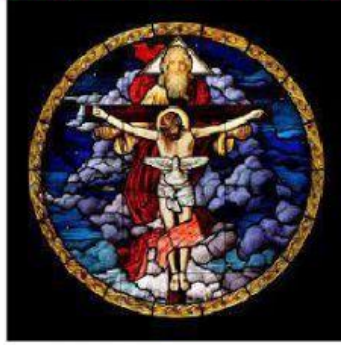


The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity
