


THE LEGEND OF SANT JORDI

The 23rd of April, “**Diada de Sant Jordi**” (or Saint George’s Day in English) is one of the most important days in the Catalan calendar.


You are going to start reading the **Legend of Sant Jordi**, a story known all over Catalonia, and even though several versions can be found, the basis is the same.




