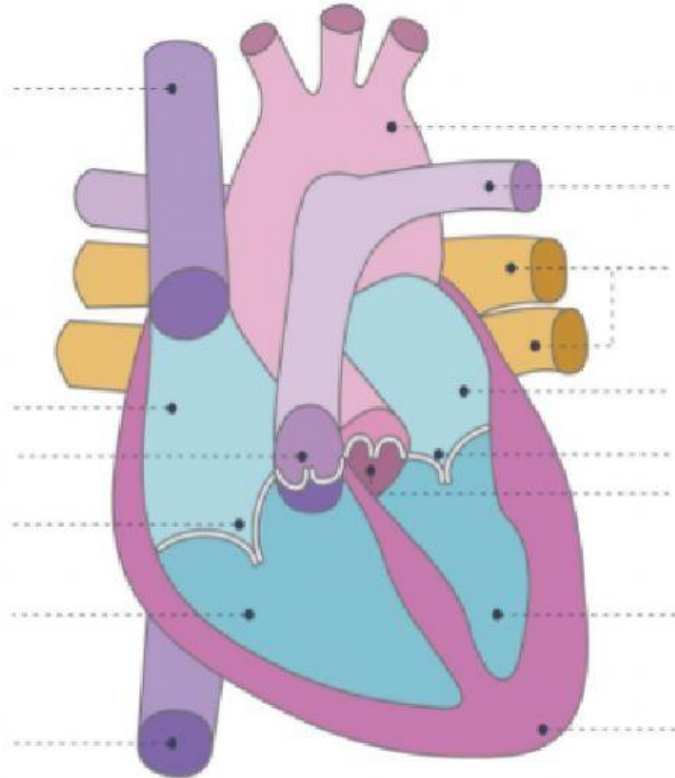


THE HUMAN HEART
