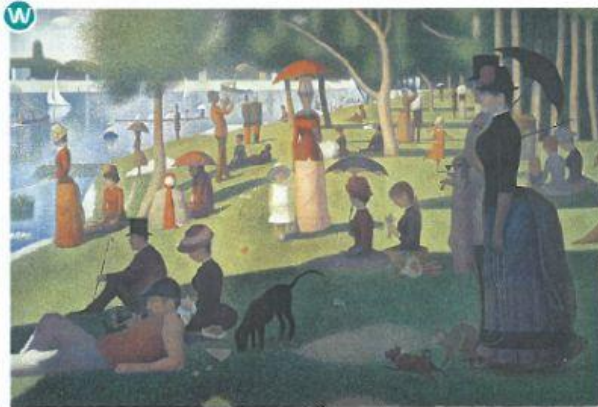


LIFE IN ART
