

PRESENT CONTINUOUS

I **AM WORKING NOW**.

HE **IS STUDYING AT THE MOMENT**.

THEY **ARE PLAYING TENNIS TODAY**.

Vamos a usar PRESENT CONTINUOUS para hablar de las acciones que estamos haciendo **NOW**: ahora, **AT THE MOMENT**: en este momento, **TODAY**: hoy.

Para formar las oraciones en afirmativo y negativo usamos esta estructura:

AFFIRMATIVE	subject	AM / IS / ARE	verb-ING.
NEGATIVE	subject	AM NOT / ISN'T / AREN'T	verb-ING.

❖ Cuando decimos **SUBJECT** nos referimos a quién realiza la acción. Puede ser un pronombre: I – HE – SHE – IT – YOU – WE – THEY o un nombre o sustantivo: Julia, the class, the children, my dad, the mobile phone.

❖ En Segundo lugar, usamos el verbo TO BE que como ya dijimos es **AM / IS / ARE** según el sujeto que tengamos:

I AM

HE/SHE/IT IS

YOU/WE/THEY ARE

❖ Por último ponemos el **VERB** con **ING**: (play) **PLAYING**, (have) **HAVING**, (run) **RUNNING**, (study) **STUDYING**, etc.

ACTIVITIES:

TENER EN CUENTA:

Si el verbo **termina en E**, al agregarle la **ING** le sacamos la **E**. Example: **HAVE – HAVING**.

El verbo **duplica la última letra** cuando termina en consonante + vocal + consonante.
Example: **GET – GETTING**
