

# Suffixes: -Able    -ful    -ish

★ A **suffix** is a word part that is added to the end of a base word. It changes the word's meaning.

It may change the type of word.

★ The suffix -able means 'able to' or 'able to be.'

breakable = 'able to be broken'

★ The suffix -ful means 'full of.'

joyful = 'full of joy'

★ The suffix -ish means 'like.'

childish = 'like a child'
