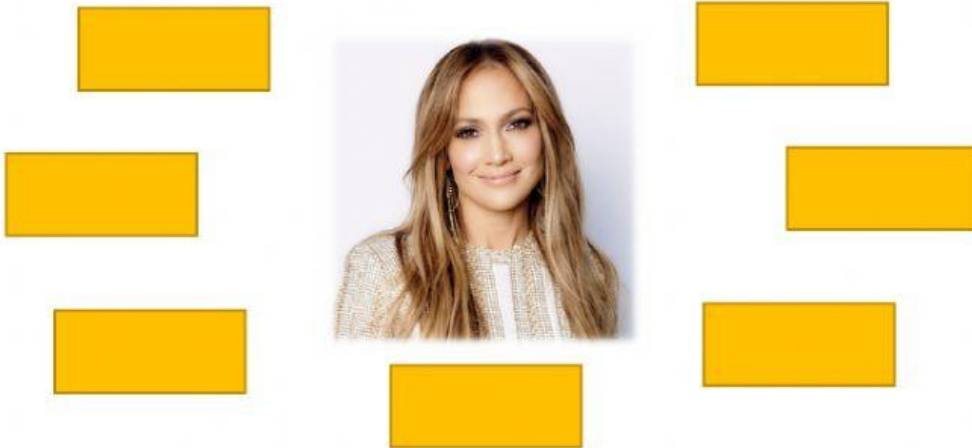


Past Perfect vs. Past Perfect Progressive

Tense	Form	Function	Examples
Past perfect	_____ + past participle.	Describes a completed event, action or state that took place before an event, action, state, or time in the past.	She had appeared in seven movies by 1997.
Past perfect progressive	_____ + _____ + -ing.	Emphasizes the duration of an event, action, or state that continued up to another event, action, state, or time in the past.	She had been working as an actress for over a decade.

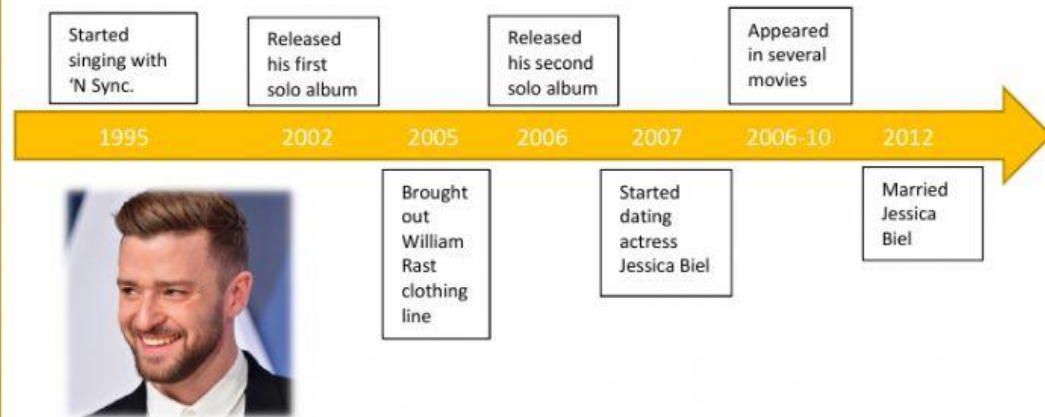
