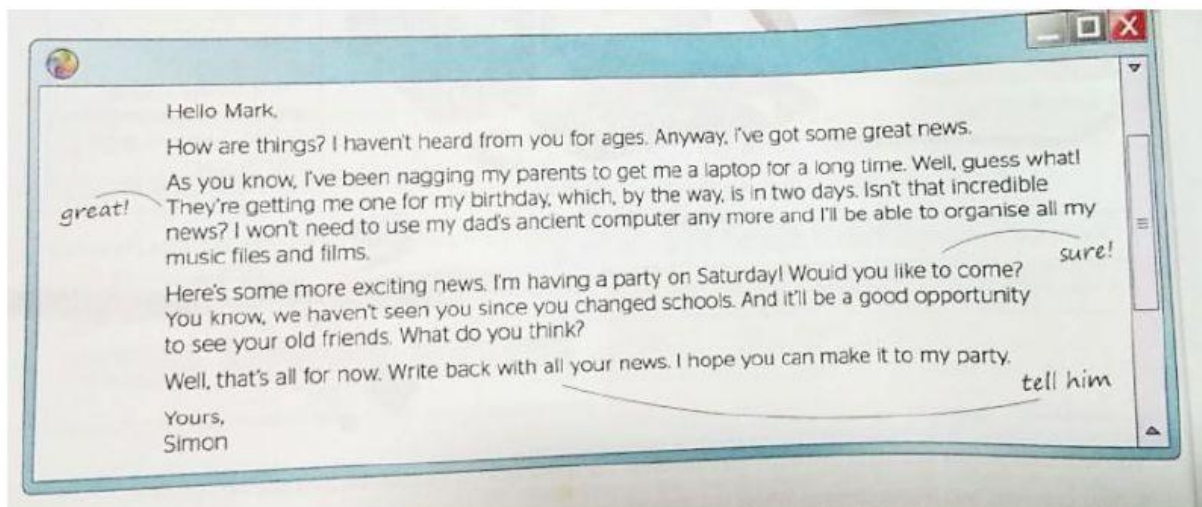


Write An informal email based on prompts
