The Subject Selection Process

This guide will contain some reminders for parents/guardians and students of the process for selecting CSEC subjects:

- ❖ Each student will pursue a minimum of seven (7) subjects in the Form 4 year unless he/she has a documented condition which requires a reduced curriculum.
- ❖ Students will automatically be assigned to pursue English A and Mathematics as these are compulsory subjects. They have a choice of five other subjects they would like to pursue.
- ❖ Students are allowed to select one subject from each numbered/horizontal line (numbers 3 to 7). These subjects are placed against each other on the F4 timetable so they cannot be selected together. For example on line 3, Add Math and Spanish will be taught at the same time. Therefore, the student must do one of the subjects but cannot do both.
- ❖ Some subjects (Add Math, Biology, Chemistry and Physics) have a pre-qualification mark. Students must earn a minimum of 75% average mark in the F3 year in order to pursue these subjects. *In addition to this, an in-person assessment will be arranged for students during the first week of the vacation.* The students must pass this assessment at 75% in order to qualify to do these courses.
- ❖ Students who wish to pursue the foreign languages are expected to have a qualifying grade in each assessment in the F3 year and to have a minimum of 70% in English Language.
- ❖ There is a limited number of students who can pursue Technical Drawing. The class is capped at 12 students. Consideration is given to those students for whom this subject is directly linked to their current career pursuits.
