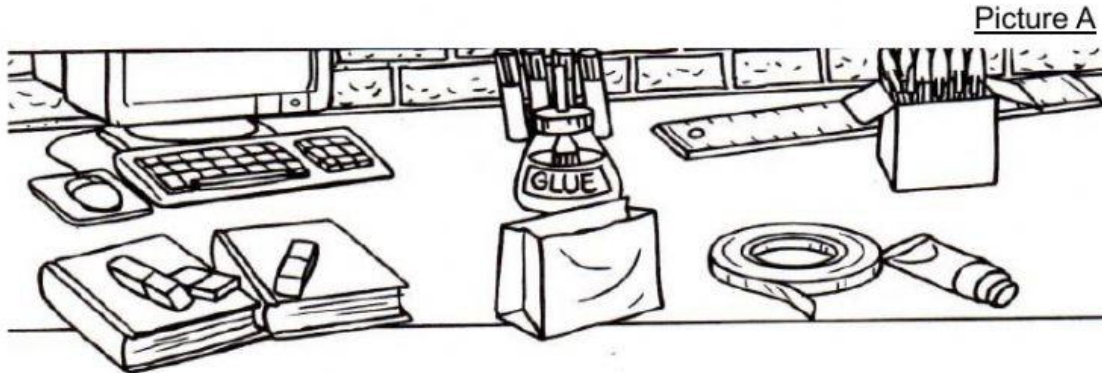


PREPOSITIONS OF PLACE.

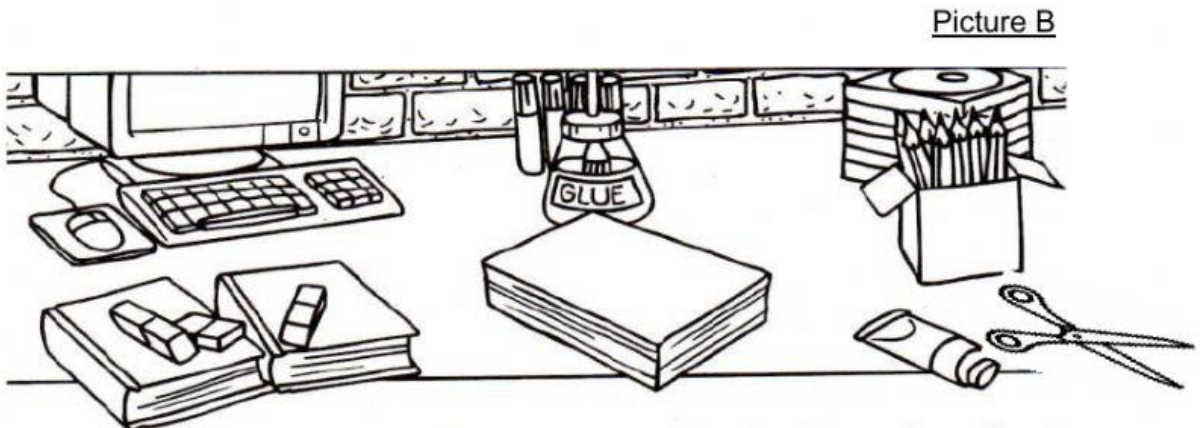
