

**Possessive Pronouns**

A possessive pronoun is a pronoun that is used to indicate possession or ownership.



**Examples**

This is my laptop. It's **mine**.

These glasses are **mine**, not **yours**.

This is my brother's book. It's **his**.

He offered to swap his camera for **hers**.

I'll show you to your room. **Ours** is next door.

The house is **yours**.

The ship is **theirs**.
