

The Future with Going To

Form



To form the future with *be going to*, use **am, is,** or **are + going to + the base form** of the verb.

| Subject | Be Verb | going to | Base Form Verb + Other Words |
|---------|---------|----------|------------------------------|
| I | am | going to | study Chinese. |
| Sandy | is | going to | visit museums. |
| They | are | going to | travel to Beijing. |
