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Error Correction – Congkak

Congkak is a popular traditional indoor (0) games in Malaysia. It is easy to play. What is (1) need to play this game is a board made from a block of wood. The wooden board is about ninety centimetres long. The bigger holes in the two ends (2) is called the 'homes'. The two rows of holes on (3) neither sides are called the 'villages'. Congkak needs two players. Each player takes turns to fill the holes (4) on seeds. The common seeds used can be marbles, seashells, beads (5) and pebbles. If the player's last 'seed' falls into a hole full of seeds, he or she then collects all the seeds and (6) distribute them into all the other holes. However, if the player's last seed falls into (7) the empty hole, his or her turn is over. The player who collects the (8) many 'seeds' in the 'home' is the winner.

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
