A: The town of Marcillac is located in Aveyron at 20km away from Rodez in the North West

B: Marcillac is also the name of a French red or rosé wine produced in the vineyard next to the town of Marcillac

C: The vineyards cover 200 hectares and produce 8000 hectolitres of wine

D: In this city you can visit the Chapelle Notre-Dame de Foncourrieu with the statue of Marie. At the beginning this building was built to thank Marie.

F: Salles-la-source is a village near Rodez. There is a waterfall. It's a very pretty and small village.
