- 6-Mr Fahd (is loved – loves- loving) by everybody in the company.
- 7-A new stadium (are built - is being built – was built) near the station now.
- 8-The sheep (was eaten – is eaten- is eating) by the wolf last week.
- 9-From six o'clock to eight o'clock, the story (was being told – is being told- is told) yesterday by my grandfather.
- 10-All the milk has (is – being – been) drunk.
- 11-All the windows had been (cleaned – clean- cleaning) by me before the storm.
- 12-The computer (is repaired - will be repaired – was repaired) tomorrow.
- 13-By next year, the new book will have been (studied – studying- study) by the students.
- 14-Dinner (was being cooked - might be cooked- was cooked) by James next week.
