

		Sarah :	That's great! <b>What is the problem?</b>
<b>Problem</b>		Adam :	I know. But, she asked me to wear it during my birthday party this Saturday. But, I think the T-shirt is horrible. I dislike the stripes and its colours because I prefer a plain T-shirt.
<b>1<sup>st</sup> Solution</b>		Sarah :	<b>Although</b> you dislike the stripes and its colours, <b>the benefit</b> would be better for your relationship with Aunt Mary. She would be glad to see you wearing it.
		Adam :	<b>The problem of</b> wearing it is that I will feel embarrassed during my birthday party. Surely, I will not enjoy it.
<b>2<sup>nd</sup> solution</b>		Sarah :	<b>Despite the problem of</b> wearing it, <b>it might be better than</b> exchanging the t-shirt with the more comfortable plain t-shirt. <b>Even though</b> you may feel comfortable with your own choice, <b>but it has the risk</b> of hurting Aunt Mary's feeling. She will be upset and feel that you do not like her choice.
		Adam :	That's right. I agree with you. It is more important to maintain the relationship with our family. Thank you for your suggestion.
		Sarah :	You are welcome. Don't forget to enjoy your birthday party.
