5. She applied some sunscreen. She didn't want to get sunburnt. AVOID.

She applied some sunscreen sunburnt.

6. They bought an old factory. They intended to turn it into a shopping mall. VIEW

They bought an old factory a shopping mall.

7. My bank counsellor contacted me. He informed me that I was overdrawn. ORDER

My bank counsellor contacted me overdrawn.

8. Let's prepare some snacks. We may have guests tonight. CASE

Let's prepare some snacks tonight.

9. She locked her passport in the hotel safe. Someone might steal it. FEAR OF

She locked her passport in the hotel safe

10. John brought me a mask. He wanted me to go out to the shop. THAT

John brought me a mask out to the shop.

11. She put away half of her pocket money. She planned to enrol in a drawing course. AIM

She put away half of her pocket money in a drawing course.

12. He revised hard for the test. He didn't want to fail. AS

He revised hard for the test
