


CONDITIONALS



IF + SIMPLE PRESENT, WILL + VERB

If I buy Tom's Cattle Breeding Services, I will obtain high quality bulls.

If Tom prints the sire summary, We will know our cattle pedigree.

If a farmer doesn't neuter a calf, it will be a bull.

If we **don't neuter** a calf, we **won't have** a steer

WE CAN WRITE THE CONDITIONAL IN ANOTHER WAY

WE WON'T HAVE A STEER IF WE DON'T NEUTER A CALF

SECOND CONDITIONAL



IMAGINARY, UNREAL OR HYPOTHETICAL SITUATION

(si OCURRIERA ESA condición, TENDRIAMOS este resultado)
Solamente algo imaginario o hipotético

If we DID the condition , we WOULD obtain the result
CONDITION RESULT

SIMPLE PAST , WOULD + VERB
(Verb+ed/2nd column) (-ria)

IF + SIMPLE PAST , WOULD + VERB

Pero para expresar deseo o algo irreal

If I **had** money , I **would buy** Tom's cattle breeding services

If all farmers **got** genetic prediction, they **would get** high quality cattle

If farmers **didn't pay** so many taxes, they **would contract** breeding services
