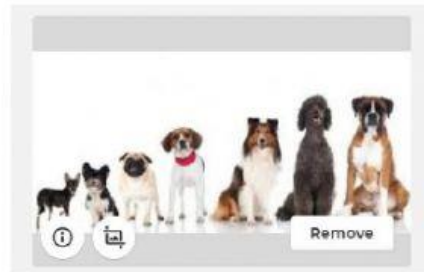


Comparatives and Superlatives

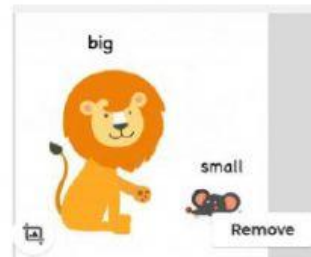

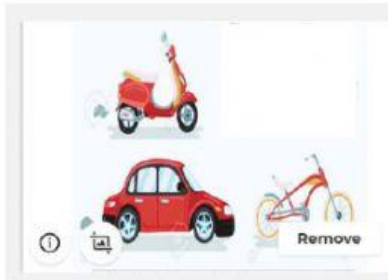
