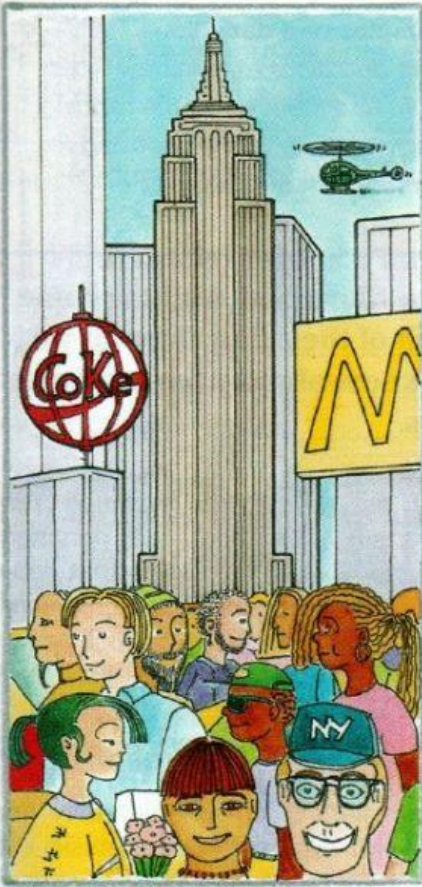


Complete the following letter by writing the verbs in parentheses in the infinitive or in the gerund.
