

1) Questions in the Simple Present Tense

To make a question in English we normally use Do or Does. It has no translation in Spanish though it is essential to show we are making a question (we could say that it replaces the initial question mark from Spanish questions). It is normally placed at the beginning of the question.

Affirmative: I/ You/ We/ They speak English.

Question: Do I/ You/ We/ They speak English?

You will see that we add **DO** at the beginning of the affirmative sentence to make it a question. We use **DO** when the subject is **I**, **you**, **we** or **they**.

Affirmative: He/She/It speaks French.

Ouestion: Does he/she/it speak French?

When the subject is he, she or it, we add DOES at the beginning to turn the affirmative sentence into a question.
