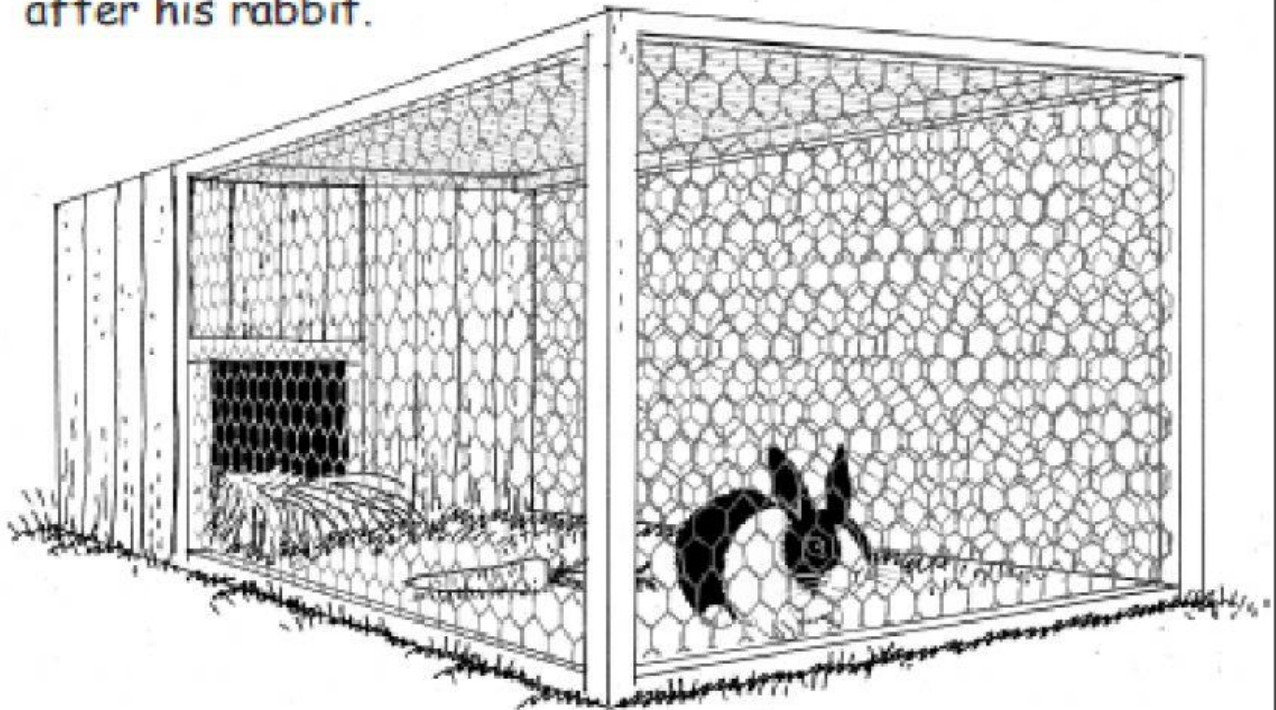


Looking After a Pet

This is what Billy wrote about looking after his body.

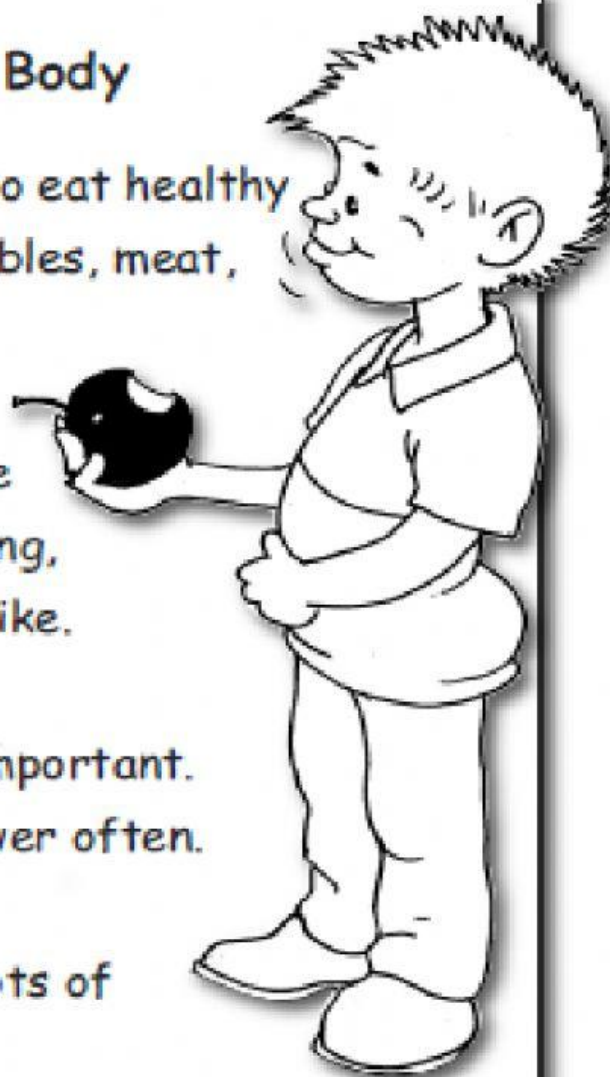
Looking After My Body
