We use the simple present to talk about ***routines and habits*** and ***preferences***.

We are going to focus only on routines and habits.

Structure:

*When we talk about us or about two or more people (I, you, we, they):

Subject + Verb + Complement
I take a shower at night.

*When we talk about another person (He, she, it):

Subject + Verb(-s) + Complement
Linda takes a shower at night.
