POSSESSIVE: -'S and -S'

singular nouns: add -'s

example: boy → boy's




The **boy's** bicycle is blue.



It belongs to the boy.

plural nouns: add -s'

example: boys → boys'



The **boys'** bicycles are blue.



They belong to the boys.

some irregular plural nouns: add -s

example: children → children's



The **children's** bicycles are blue.



They belong to the children.
