


His attention to design, function and style won him millions of fans. He died in October 2011, at the age of 56.

She became famous all over the world for starting the Missionaries of Charity in Calcutta, India.

She **began** this work in 1950 and for over forty years, she **looked** after the poor, sick, orphaned, and dying.

She **decided** to become a nun when she was 12.

She **arrived** in India in 1929 and became a nun two years later.

She was an international symbol of charity.
