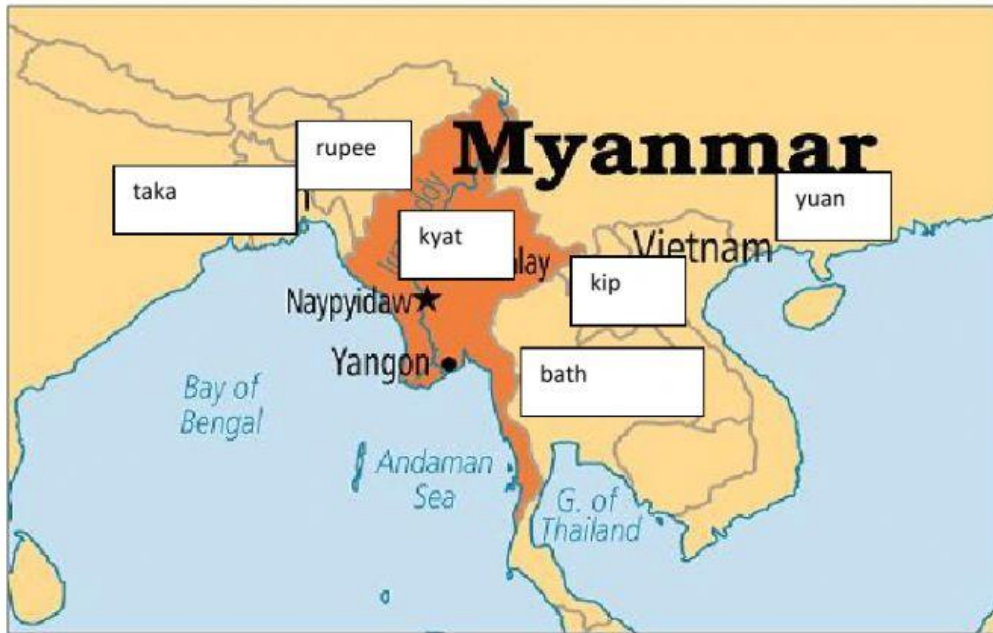


Read the passage.
