

REFLEXIVE PRONOUNS

We use the REFLEXIVE PRONOUNS when we want to show that *the person who did the action also received the action.*

1. COMPLETE THE TABLE WITH THE REFLEXIVE PRONOUN:

I	you	he	she	it	we	you	they

2. CHOOSE THE CORRECT REFLEXIVE PRONOUN

- Suzie made a sandwich **herself** / **himself** / **themselves**.
- I choose this hoodie **himself** / **ourselves** / **myself**.
- The students wrote the school play **themselves** / **ourselves** / **itself**.
- Did you pay for these sunglasses **ourselves** / **myself** / **yourself** ?
- My friends and I designed our new school uniform **yourselves** / **myself** / **ourselves** .
- Dad decorated the cake **itself** / **myself** / **himself**.
- Graciela made this oil painting **himself** / **myself** / **herself**.
- It was too windy that the door moved **herself** / **itself** / **myself**.
- We all have done a lot of work in the classroom. We decorated the classroom **ourselves** / **themselves** / **yourselves**.
